

We hope everyone is staying safe and keeping well during this time.

As your Travel Plan Coordinators we thought it would be good to provide an update on how COVID 19 has impacted the local transport services in your area (for those who still need to travel) and provide the results of the travel surveys completed at the end of last year.

Survey Results

At the end of 2019, we undertook our biannual travel surveys where we offered a £20 Love2Shop voucher to everyone that completed the survey. We received a whopping 38% response rate, so a big thank you from us to all those who participated.

The results of our Year 1 Travel Survey results indicate that:

- 79% of Quebec Park residents travel by car alone for their primary journeys whilst 12% car share, 6% use public transport and 3% walk.
- Frequency of alternative travel mode use by Quebec Park residents ranged from 11% stating once a week, 26% stated once a month and never and 11% of residents stated they use an alternative mode of travel once a week.
- There has been continued interest in setting up a development Bicycle User Group and Car Sharing Page. We will be issuing an email to those who have signed up once we are able to promote this again. We need volunteers to take over the management of these groups. If you are interested please get in contact with us.

Need to travel during Lockdown?

There has been a change to the way we are able to travel during lockdown. The Government has recommended not to car share and to travel by car where possible. If you do not own a car and need help traveling to work or for an essential trip we are here to help! Changes to Bus Services

Local bus services operated by Stagecoach including the 13, 18 and 23 services are still available from the Post Office Bus stop on Camp Road. The Number 18 bus service will continue to run broadly every hour Monday to Saturday, with the service running as normal on Sundays and Bank Holidays.
